## HARBOR-UCLA MEDICAL CENTER

A 553 bed, Level 1 Trauma Center serving Los Angeles County in the city of Torrance, California. Harbor-UCLA is situated on a 72-acre campus consisting of the main eight-floor hospital building, a state-of-the-art Emergency/Trauma and Surgery building with 51 treatment bays, 16 operating room suites, 8 intensive care units, and many outlying outpatient clinics. In addition to the main hospital, the campus includes several research buildings and outlying clinical laboratories.

At present, the Department of Radiology performs over 250,000 diagnostic exams per year, which encompass all imaging modalities.

## **HOSPITAL STAFF**

The hospital faculty consists of approximately 300 full-time staff physicians who are devoted to patient care, education and research, as well as over 450 part-time and volunteer clinical faculty.

This offers the resident a broad exposure to interests and abilities of the full-time academic physicians as well as those of the private practicing, volunteer specialists.

## RESIDENCY

The Harbor-UCLA Diagnostic Radiology Residency Program has a total of 24 residents, with 6 residents in each class. There are an additional 1-2 fellows per year in breast imaging and neuroradiology. All residents are designated as postgraduate students of the University of California and, as such, have privileges at the University. Fellows are appointed Adjunct Instructors in the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA.

The four-year, fully-accredited residency program is designed to meet all the requirements for board-certification in Diagnostic Radiology. The faculty-to-resident ratio is 1:1 or 1:2 on all service rotations.

## **INTERNSHIP**

Harbor-UCLA offers linked intern year positions with the Radiology Residency program (6 Prelim Internal Medicine and 6 Prelim Surgery positions). Applicants must complete at least one year of clinical internship/residency before starting the Diagnostic Radiology residency program. Per the ACGME, residents must not do more than 2 months of radiology during their internship, and any radiology electives must be done at an ACGME-accredited radiology program.

## **LICENSURE**

Residents must pass the USMLE Step 3 exam before the start of their Diagnostic Radiology Residency program at Harbor-UCLA.

Trainees in CA must obtain a Post Graduate Training License (PTL) within 180 days of enrollment in their intern year.


Trainees who have 12 months or more of ACGME training must obtain a full and unrestricted CA Physicians and Surgeons License. To transition from a PTL to a Physician's and Surgeon's License, you must have taken and passed all Steps of the USMLE and received credit for 12 months of board approved training. Trainees must obtain a full & unrestricted CA Physician's & Surgeon's license within 90 days of enrollment in the Radiology residency program.

## **SALARY & BENEFITS**

The current yearly stipends for residents are as follows:

(PGY-2) \$61,728; (PGY-3) \$66,883; (PGY-4) \$72,074; and, (PGY-5) \$77,125.

Uniforms, laundry, meals, as well as liability, health and disability insurance are all provided.



## **TRAINING**

There are 10 hours of Departmental conferences per week. These include daily noon lectures and weekly interdisciplinary conferences in chest, nuclear medicine, neuroradiology, vascular surgery, breast and interventional radiology.

There is a special series of early morning lectures for the first-year residents, which is taught by the faculty and upper-level residents.

Each year, residents are given a stipend to attend an educational conference of their choice.

In the third year, trainees are sent to the American Institute for Radiologic Pathology (AIRP) in Maryland for a month-long course. The Department also pays for board review and physics review courses for the third-year residents.

Each year, all residents are given one week for research, one week to attend a conference of their choosing, and 4 weeks of vacation.

Radiology residency trainees typically pursue an additional year of fellowship training, and graduates of our program have done well matching into the fellowship programs of their choice (see page 11).

## **CALL**


Diagnostic call after-hours is based on a night-float system. Weekends and holiday call are divided amongst the 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> year radiology residents. 1st-year radiology residents do not take diagnostic call, but do participate in back-up call on IR.

## **ROTATIONS**

There are 12 four-week rotations each year, plus a special four-week holiday block. This curriculum allows residents to rotate through all the major disciplines in radiology.

## TORRANCE, CA

Harbor-UCLA is located in the city of Torrance, which is close to beaches and downtown Los Angeles, and not far from the mountains. There is easy access to a wealth of cultural and recreational activities throughout Southern California, with year-round warm temperatures and an average of 329 days of sunshine.











## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

After the application is complete and has been looked over by the selection committee, some applicants will be invited for an interview. This will allow the applicant to evaluate the professional and educational environment, as well as the faculty to assess the applicant.

Application, transcripts, MSPE, photograph, CV, personal statement, USMLE results and three letters of recommendation from physicians or faculty members are required. Completed applications should be submitted through ERAS (Electronic Residency Application Service).


